The Appalachian Trail and the Delaware Water Gap are in trouble. PSE&G has applied to the National Park to replace the existing 80' tall power lines with 195' monster towers.

The construction and final height of these towers will ruin the views and natural resources of this Wild and Scenic area.

Their proposal is much greater than what is needed for electricity reliability. This project is motivated by greed not need.

For months residents have fought this project at every turn.
